How to apply for VA Benefits using VA Form 22-1990 (as of January 2017)

## <u>STEP 1:</u>

- Visit the following website: <u>https://www.vets.gov</u>
- OR visit Google and type in: "VA Form 22-1990"

## <u>STEP 2:</u>

• Visit <u>www.vets.gov</u> and select "Start Form 22-1990"

## What are the steps to apply with Form 22-1990?

### Prepare

#### **Check your eligibility**

You may be eligible for more than one benefit, based on your service. When you apply, you have to pick which one you want to use:

- <u>Post- 9/11 GI Bill</u> (Chapter 33)
- Montgomery GI Bill (MGIB-AD, Chapter 30)
- <u>Montgomery GI Bill Selected Reserve</u> (MGIB-SR, Chapter 1606)
- <u>Post-Vietnam Era Veterans' Educational Assistance Program</u> (VEAP, Chapter 32)

An accredited representative 📑 with a Veterans Service Organization (VSO) can help you pick the right program.

- Social Security number
- Bank account direct deposit information
- Education and military history
- Basic information about the school or training facility where you want to attend

#### **Other Ways to Apply**

- Go to a VA regional office and have a VA employee assist you.
- Work with your school's VA certifying official. This person is usually in the Registrar or Financial Aid office at the school of your choice.
- Call 888-442-4551 (888-GI-BILL-1) from 8:00 a.m. 7:00 p.m. ET Mon Fri, to have the application mailed to you. Fill it out and mail it to your <u>VA regional claims processing</u> office →.

• There are several steps that you'll need to go through in order to complete the application.

- You can't make changes to your application.

- There are 8 steps for the application that you'll need to go through. Be sure to have all of your information readily available, including bank routing & account number, dates of military service and high school graduation date information. This will help you complete the application.



• For Step 2, ensure that you have selected the correct benefit that you are applying for. Failure to select the correct benefit may result in a delay in processing and approval.
