Liability information for the Internship Experience

Liability insurance may be required by your internship site and even if it is not, carrying liability insurance is a wise move. Your service to others comes with legal risk. Accidents simply happen. Regardless of training environment, any number of day-to-day factors can pose a risk, even if managed and mitigated with great attention. Don't risk your career and your professional reputation. Liability insurance provides helps to protect you from expenses incurred if you have to defend yourself in a lawsuit. It would be good to get \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$3,000,000 aggregate. Consult a lawyer if you are unsure.

There are four options listed below. There may be other available carriers but it would be on your shoulders to investigate other sources for liability insurance.

Option 1: Personal. Consult with your or your parent's personal insurance agent and see if a "rider" can be attached to the policies you already have. You should ask about PROFESSIONAL liability insurance <u>not</u> personal liability insurance. Minimal levels are advised to be \$1,000,000 per incident and \$3,000,000 aggregate.

Option 2: ACSM. The American College of Sports Medicine offers liability insurance to its members. The first year of student membership in ACSM is only \$10. Insurance of offered to ACSM Members and ACSM Certified Professionals. Forrest T. Jones (FTJ) is the insurance company that represents ACSM.
