Dual Enrollment Agreement

This Agreement is entered into by and between the School District of Philadelphia (hereinafter referred to as the "School District") located at 7100 Henry Avenue in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, part of the Philadelphia School District, West Chester University of Pennsylvania (hereinafter referred to as the "University") an educational institution of the State System of Higher Education, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and Steppingstone Scholars (hereinafter referred to as "Steppingstone"), an educational social mobility organization that creates pathways to college and the workforce for talented, underserved students in the City of Philadelphia. This Agreement sets out the terms and conditions of the Dual Enrollment program offered by the School District and University in accordance with Article XVI-B of the Public School Code (hereinafter "Program"). This Agreement also sets out the terms and conditions for Steppingstone to provide Steppingstone Scholar Students in their junior and senior year at Walter B. Saul High School with a designated scholarship to participate in West Chester University's dual enrollment program (hereinafter referred to as "program") for the Spring 2022 semester.

The University and School District do hereby agree to the following:

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- a. The student is a high school junior or senior and a participant in the Steppingstone Scholars Program at Walter B. Saul High School.
- b. The student is making satisfactory progress toward fulfilling applicable secondary school graduation requirements, as determined by the School District.
- a. In order to participate in this program, the student is required to have a secondary school cumulative grade point average of 2.8. Students who do not meet this requirement will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. The student also must maintain a minimum grade of "C" in the dual enrollment course.
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The following criteria apply to the Writing 120 Course covered by this Agreement:

- a. The Writing 200 Critical Writing and Research course is non-remedial. This threecredit course continues the expository writing experience offered in Effective Writing I (Writing 120), and explores techniques of gathering, evaluating, and selecting materials to be used in writing research papers.
