LIT 165. Section 99. Topics in Literature. 3 credits.

A course designed to develop awareness of literature as being central to all the arts, to increase levels of literacy and critical faculties, and to broaden understanding of the human condition.

SOC 100. Section 22. Introduction to Sociology. 3 credits

This course introduces students to the sociological study of society. Sociology focuses on the systematic understanding of social interaction, social organization, social institutions, and social change.
