Course Description and Prerequisite:

Topics include polynomial, rational, exponential, logarithmic, and trigonometric functions. An emphasis is placed on understanding function properties and graphs without the use of technology. Successful completion of this course prepares students for MAT 161: Calculus I. MAT 131 requires a prerequisite of a "B" or better in high school Algebra I and Algebra II and a recommendation form signed by the student's high school math teacher. If the student is currently taking Algebra II, a "B" or better on the latest progress report is acceptable.
