

### Faculty Research Spotlight

Congratulations to Dr. Kolasinski on his newest patent "Injection Metal Assisted Catalytic Etching"! This patent was the product of research performed by Dr. Kolasinski and (then) undergraduate Brett Unger here at WCU; both inventors on the patent.

The patent describes a process in which we use metal nanoparticles to catalyze the formation of pores with sizes that we can control in the range from 4-20 nm. Metals such as copper, silver, gold, palladium or platinum are deposited silicon then exposed to aqueous hydrofluoric acid and hydrogen peroxide to make porous silicon. We are investigating the application of porous silicon related to drug delivery, wound care and rechargable batteries. The figure represents the process.
