	teaching laboratory activities within the College, in
	cooperation with the Director of Environmental Health and

	Safety.
Director of Public Safety	<ul> <li>Provides timely, simultaneous notice to the DEA, the Chief Academic, the Chief Human Resources Officer, the Director of Environmental Health and Safety, University Legal Counsel, and the President when a criminal investigation is undertaken and when it concludes.</li> <li>The point of contact with the DEA in possible criminal matters involving use of controlled substances in research or teaching laboratory work on campus.</li> </ul>
Chief Procurement Officer	<ul> <li>Establishes and ensures that DEA Registrants know and comply with University procurement rules and policies.</li> <li>Reports any procurement-related violations to the Dean of the College.</li> </ul>
Legal Counsel	<ul> <li>Provides legal advice to the University decision-makers when questions of law arise in association with the use of controlled substances in research and teaching laboratory work on campus.</li> </ul>
