* FAFSA 2022-2023

The 2022-2023 FAFSA opens on October 1st at fafsa.ed.gov. The sooner you and your student complete the application, the better. You will use last year's tax information.

* Staying Safe

October brings several opportunities for students to engage socially. While student safety is our utmost priority here at WCU, it is also important that your family reinforces messages related to health and safety. Ask open-ended questions about their experiences with drugs and alcohol and share that you trust them to make good decisions that keep them out of harm's way.

* Homesickness

Reassure your student that feeling overwhelmed and/or experiencing homesickness is normal as students adjust to their academic demands and personal responsibilities. When your student calls, use these moments to listen carefully and empower them to do their own self-advocacy.

* Spring Course Registration

Students must check their myWCU for their course scheduling time. Encourage them to create a tentative schedule using their Degree Progress Report, make an appointment, and meet with their Academic Advisor to discuss their plans prior to their scheduling date.

* Thanksgiving Re-Charge

Take the brief Thanksgiving break to celebrate the semester's victories thus far and work together to discuss challenges (and potential solutions!). If midterm grades were disappointing, your student's confidence may be shaken. Encourage them to reflect on what went wrong and what they can improve before finals to finish strong.

* New Year, Fresh Start

Your student learned a lot about how to "do college" last semester, and now they can put these insights to good use starting on the first day of classes. Remind them to take advantage of in-person and online tutoring opportunities and meet with their professors during their Office Hours to get a head start this spring.

* Major Changes

Now that your student has completed the fall semester, changing majors may be on their mind. Encourage your student to meet with their advisor to discuss their interests and what they really want to study. Once students decide to change your major, they can request an official Change of Major through their myWCU account.

* Financial Planning

Talk to your student about their financial needs for the spring semester and have a conversation about budgeting, expenses, spending habits, and paying for their education. Evaluate the need and/or benefits of a parttime job. Encourage your student to explore scholarship opportunities at wcupa.edu/scholarships.

* Career Development

The Twardowski Career Development Center assists students with career exploration and professional development. Encourage your student to make an appointment with a Career Counselor to explore majors and careers, search for jobs and internships, prepare for interviewing, write, and revise resumes and cover letters, and so much more.

* Identity Development

Identity development is critical to student success. Encourage your student to attend programs offered by the Dowdy Multicultural Center, Center for Trans and Queer Advocacy, and the Center for Women and Gender Equity. These offices provide spaces for students to drop-in, find community, attend educational programs, and make new connections.

* College Relationships

Relationships often become a focus in February. Listen as your student shares about their relationships with friends and significant others and remind them to keep themselves safe. Often, the best thing you can do to help your student is offer an understanding, empathetic ear.

Many students choose to participate in Alterative Spring Break opportunities, immersion trips where students do service and learn about different populations and regions. The Office of Service Learning and Volunteer Programs can help your student find an opportunity to serve in our community or beyond.

* Safe Spring Break

If your student plans to go away for spring break, remind them of your expectations and have a conversation about keeping themselves and others safe. Reinforce calling 911 in an emergency. If they are staying home or on-campus, encourage them to use this time to apply for summer jobs, scholarships, and to get ahead on their schoolwork.

* Planning Ahead

Ask your student about their summer plans and encourage them to use on-campus resources to explore opportunities for jobs, internships, travel, or summer coursework to make the most of the time off.
