- Met with Mike Reno and David Comas, on Wednesday, February 5th at 1:30pm.
  - Discussed the approval of the boxing club and how that could impact the rec center and other recreation facilities on campus. Dan and Mike shared concerns about student interest in the clubs. We talked about having 82 intramural basketball teams, and how the season has been going now that games have started. Everything has been running smoothly and as expected. This year is the first time we've had a 9-team women's league in the rec center's history. Pickleball and Women's Volleyball are newer clubs from last semester.
  - Discussed that there are 52 group fitness classes per week which is more than previous semesters. The rec center is now offering classes for student orgs at the organization's request. These would be hosted at the student rec center.
  - Discussed, the annual spring semester Career Fair will be held at the rec center February 26th from 12-4pm.
  - Discussed that Project Wise which is the outdoor basketball court is getting refurbished! The full remodel will include new baskets, a resurfaced and relined court. The Rec will be getting a new water heater within the next month.
