Hi New Ram! Let's talk class schedules!

All new first-year Golden Rams have their fall class schedules developed for them by WCU faculty and staff. You'll find the basic information below, but the first-year scheduling process is explained in more detail <u>here</u> if you'd like to know more.

Before scheduling starts, each student needs to complete their First-Year Enrollment Portal, found under *Current Tasks* in myWCU. **Scheduling starts June 15th**, **so if you want to be included in the first round of scheduling it's important you complete your Portal before then.** If you complete it after the 15th, you'll be included in a later round of scheduling, but you won't be scheduled until you complete your Portal!

Your First-Year Enrollment Portal is unique to you based on your major. Here's an outline of what you can expect:

- Writing Placement Assessment (also referred to as the WRITE Survey) All incoming first-year and transfer students are required to complete the WRITE Survey. The WRITE Survey determines which Writing course sequence (out of four possibilities) is likely to be the best fit for you. Once it's submitted, you can't modify your answers.
- <u>Math Placement Assessment</u> WCU encourages you to take this assessment once, then retake it at least one more time to ensure you get the proper math course placement. Before you can retake the assessment, you'll have to complete the self-paced Prep and Learning Modules that are designed to help you get a better score.
- Second Language Placement Test Anyone pursuing a Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) degree at WCU must complete a foreign language as part of their graduation requirements. Based on your placement test results, you may "test out" of the language requirement. If not, you'll be placed in the appropriate level of your chosen language.
- <u>Theory and Musicianship Placement</u> This applies to *Bachelor of Music students only.*
