

- 1) All billing related information is available online via myWCU. From there, you can access on-demand statements, find information about due dates, and make payments.
- 2) We offer flexible payment options for students. You can find directions for payment plans on our homepage.
- 3) Students can choose to receive their refunds electronically via the direct deposit link in myWCU.
- 4) Parents or guardians may access billing and payment information via the Parent Portal. Students must authorize parents or guardians to have access.
- 5) Students can also pay parking tickets and judicial fines from our homepage.

Key Takeaways

Students should check their WCU email account regularly. If applicable, students should also give their parents or guardians access to their billing information in the Parent Portal & QuikPAY.

- How can parents and guardians gain access to student bills?
