The Ram Card Office is responsible for managing WCU's ID card, the Ram Card. We provide ID cards for the campus community and manage the Ram Bucks program.

Fast Facts

- 1) The Ram Card is the name for the campus ID card. It is the key to accessing all the services available to students on campus.
- 2) Flex Dollars and Ram Bucks are the two spending accounts you can access on your Ram Card. Flex Dollars can only be used at on-campus Aramark dining locations. Ram Bucks can be used both on campus and at more than 70 off-campus locations.
- 3) Our office offers several student employment opportunities excluding Federal Work Study.

- What does the Ram Card provide access to?
 - Your Ram Card gives you access to your residence hall, the campus recreation center, computer labs, and the library.
- What else do students need their Ram Card for?
 - The Ram Card is the only way to access your meal plan and Flex Dollars. Your Ram Card also allows you to print on campus and attend campus events that require students to sign in or register.
- What is the difference between Flex and Ram Bucks?
 - Your Flex Dollars account can only be used on campus and is meant to supplement your campus dining plan. Ram Bucks act as a "super debit" account. They can be used both on campus and at many locations off campus, at the campus store, and at any vending machine on campus.
