It is the student's responsibility to ensure they follow all federal, state, county, and university Guidelines. Failure to follow the guidelines may result in a loss of housing.

Students may be required to wait in line to be checked into the building.

	Stay home if you feel sick and contact the WCU Health Services.	
	Wash your hands often . Everyone should practice regular hand hygiene as advised by the CDC. Research continues to support that washing your hands with soap and water is one of the best ways to remove germs, avoid getting sick and prevent the spread of germs to others. Always wash your hands after you touch highly touched surfaces (such as doorknobs, elevator buttons and photo copiers) and avoid touching your face,	
	especially after coming into contact with these highly touched surfaces.	
	Face Coverings - You will be required to wear a personal face covering/mask in all common areas of the building	
	Social Distancing - Students will need to practice 6 feet of safe social distancing.	
	Family unit is defined as a group of students who share an apartment, suite or bathroom	
	 USH students and their roommates are considered a family unit. USH students will be required to clean their own bathrooms and common area spaces 	
	 WCU Traditional students who share a bathroom on the same floor are considered a family unit. 	
	Students will be required to wipe down the bathroom area after each use.
