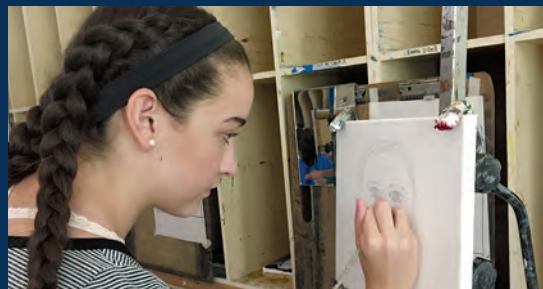

### Ceramics

### Drawing

Students will study traditional still life and on-site landscape sketching.

### Painting

Acrylics will be used to develop abstract and realistic still-life studies. Color theory will also be investigated.

### Digital Art

An introduction of the use of computer as a tool to create solutions to graphic design problems.

### Mixed Media | Fiber Art

Students will fabricate original designs using a variety of fibers and textiles.

### Sculpture

Students will design and build their own three dimensional art forms.

### Mosaic

Using small pieces of tile and china, students will form their own ceramic designs.
