

# Studio Activities

## Ceramics

Sculptural hand building and wheel throwing techniques as well as glazing and finishing will be explored.

## Drawing

Students will study traditional still life and on-site landscape sketching.

## Painting

Acrylics will be used to develop abstract and realistic still-life studies. Color theory will also be investigated.

## Digital Art

An introduction of the use of the computer as a tool to create solutions to graphic design problems.

## Mixed Media / Fiber Art

Students will fabricate original designs using a variety of fibers and textiles.

## Sculpture

Students will design and build their own three dimensional art forms.

## Mosaic

Using small pieces of tile and china, students will form their own mosaic designs.
