Core Courses

Students must take the following courses:

- WRH 225: Introduction to Professional and Technical Writing (3 cr)
- ENG 368: Business & Organizational Writing (3 cr) **OR** ENG 371: Technical Writing (3 cr)

Elective Courses

Students will choose **three** of the following courses:

- ENG 320: Usability & User Experience (3 cr)
- ENG 368: Business & Organizational Writing (if not used to meet the core requirement) (3 cr)
- ENG 371: Technical Writing (if not used to meet the core requirement) (3 cr)
- ENG 375: Client-Based Writing (3 cr)
- WRH 320: Writing for the Web (3 cr)
- WRH 340: Visual Rhetoric (3 cr)
- WRH 342: Document Design (3 cr)
- WRH 345: Professional and Technical Editing (3 cr)
- WRH 350: Grant and Proposal Writing (3 cr)
- WRH 360: Social Media Writing (3 cr) *or* MDC 325: Strategic Social Media *or* MKT 355: Social Media Marketing
- WRH 365: Writing in the Health Professions (3 cr)
- WRH 370: Science Writing (3 cr)
- WRH 405: Topics in Professional and Technical Writing (may be repeated once for credit) (3 cr)

Other elective(s) may be approved by the program coordinators. Independent studies (ENG 410) focused on topics in professional and technical writing may count as program electives with the approval of PTW Minor coordinator(s).

Internship

- ENG 395: Internship (3-12 cr)

*Note: The program strongly recommends that students have an internship during the last semester of the minor. Students **must** complete both core courses and have at least 90 credits before they can take an internship.*
