ACADEMIC OVERVIEW

WCU and IAU College's co-sponsored January Term (J-Term) Traveling Seminar is designed for students interested in an academic and cultural experience in France, Morocco, Gibraltar and Spain. The academic component consists of a series of briefings from leading European academic, literary and political personalities and experts on the European relationship with the Islamic world. Participants will spend 18 nights in 12 cities and will attend daily lectures and meetings with distinguished scholars from WCU and IAU in addition to local guides and experts in the field of politics, French, Spanish, art history, history and culture. Special emphasis will be placed on the importance of North African immigration to Europe and its current socio-cultural implications.
