Department of Theatre and Dance - Out of State Scholarship

This scholarship is for all incoming out of state theatre majors. Students should have a GPA of at least 3.0 and be involved in their high school theater program. The scholarship is awarded to one student in the amount of \$5,000 per year, with the possibility of renewal for four years. A minimum GPA of 3.0 is required for renewal.

To apply for the scholarship, students will be asked to submit the following written materials:

1. Fill out the attached form and attach a theater resume (if you have one) with two references.
2. A short response to the following question: Why are you passionate about being a theatre artist? (250-500 words)

In addition to the written materials, students will be asked to submit a link to an uploaded video submission that contains the following items:

1. Verbal answers to the following:
 - a. What are your greatest strengths as a theatre artist?
 - b. Talk about someone that you know that inspires you creatively.
 - c. Tell us something interesting about you.
2. Audition or portfolio submission: (Pick one of these)
 - a. 45-60 seconds of monologue
 - b. 16-32 bars of musical number
 - c. Portfolio/images of design work and an explanation of your design process in creating that design. Please include challenges and point to those things that you are most proud of accomplishing.
