West Chester University's Certificate in Human Resource Management will advance your skills in the field of human resources. The program is designed for both HR and non-HR professionals across industries and organizational types and is available 100% online. The 12-credit program is structured to develop core skills in critical areas of HR management including employment and labor relations; compensation and benefits; employee and labor relations; ethics; global human resources; human resource metrics; leadership and change management; and workforce planning.

OUTCOMES

Entry level Human Resource Specialists with no experience can earn up to \$59,180 per year according to the Bureau of Labor Statistics (2016). The median annual wage for Human Resource Managers with five years or more of professional management experience was \$106,910 in May 2016, according to the Bureau of Labor Statistics.

Possible careers include: Human Resource Specialist, Human Resource Generalist, Human Resource Coordinator, Human Resource Recruiter, Entry-level Payroll Specialist, Benefits Coordinator, and more.













ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The Graduate Certificate in Human Resource Management applications are processed year-round. A complete application to the program consists of the following items for admission consideration:

- All official undergraduate transcripts, and any official graduate transcripts,
- 2. A detailed, professional essay that addresses the applicant's career plans,
- 3. A current resume
- 4. Two letters of recommendation. At least one of the letters of recommendation must be from a professional supervisor or colleague. The program will accept a professor's recommendation in lieu of a professional recommendation for traditional students without work experience.
