

# Honors College Advising


Important information for Honors  
students as they schedule each semester.



# Steps to Take

- Find your major-related advisement sheet on the Honors Website:
  - <https://www.wcupa.edu/viceProvost/honorsCollege/advising.aspx>
- Schedule a meeting with your department-assigned advisor, found on your mywcu account.
  - Bring your advisement sheet to this meeting – explain how this sheet lists all the classes you are required to take.
- Look for your Honors Course Schedule (generally sent in an email from Michelle) to see what Honors classes your Honors cohort is set to take this semester. Remember, you can take Seminars during an semester!
- \*\*\*if you're a Bridge Student, please consult with Dr. Dean to ensure you are taking the classes you need.





# Helpful Tips

- Check the Honors Student Directory for upperclass students in your major—they are a great resource for questions!
- Create a spreadsheet including each semester up to graduation and fill it in as you complete and plan courses to help you stay on track!
- Try to plan when an Honors Seminar would best fit with your other classes—remember, they change each semester!

## Things to Note:

- When checking your Degree Progress Report (DPR) on mywcu, DO NOT PANIC! **Cross check any “missing areas” with your advisement sheet.** In most cases, one of your Honors classes has fulfilled the area, and you just need a note from your advisor to verify this.
  - Before you graduate, Dr. Dean puts these notes in and approves you for graduation.
- With ANY advisement questions, Dr. Dean should be your first line of communication – he has the necessary knowledge of each department’s advising plan for Honors.
