VSA Future Plans Survey Spring 2014: Graduate Program Students

During late April and early May of 2014, the Office of Institutional Research of the West Chester University of Pennsylvania (WCU) conducted a survey of students who were graduating with a Master's degree in May 2014. The purpose of the survey was to assess their future plans. The survey consisted of the broad question: "What is most likely to be your principal activity upon graduation?", as well as, follow-up by questions depending on the graduates' response category. A total of 178 students responded to the online survey. This represents approximately 42.7% of the 417 students graduating. The findings of the survey are displayed below.



For the 148 students who indicated employment, full-time as their primary plan after graduation, 78 indicated they had accepted a position or were continuing on in their current position. 72 students provided further information on their salary range. The survey contains a question pertaining to if the student completed either an internship, practicum, student teaching, field experience, etc. while at West Chester University. There were 30 students from the College of Arts and Sciences, 39 from the College of Business and Public Affairs, 32 from the College of Education, 15 from the College of Health Sciences, and 3 from the College of Visual and Performing Arts who completed either an internship, practium, student teaching, or field experience.
