
Future Plans of Spring 2009 WCUPA Undergraduate Graduates

In April and May of 2009 the West Chester University of Pennsylvania (WCUPA) Office of Institutional Research conducted a survey of undergraduate students who were graduating in May 2009. The purpose of the survey was to assess their future plans. The survey consisted of the following question: What is most likely to be your principal activity upon graduation? There were a total of 419 students who responded to the survey which was administered when students picked up their cap and gown for graduation. This represents approximately 37% of the 1,138 students graduating. The findings of the survey are displayed in the charts below.
