The process of reintegrating into the community following a long and difficult hospital stay can be overwhelming, stressful, and discouraging. Community reintegration programming, run by professionals in partnership with community organizations, provides opportunities to practice skills in a safe, supported, and sometimes even a fun environment. This presentation reviews the design, collaboration, and implementation of a successful community reintegration program for pediatric burn survivors, that grew from a partnership between a hospital and the local fire department.
