Presenters will outline the SHARP framework (Structural Oppression, Historical Context Analysis of Role, Reciprocity, and Power) as detailed in *SHARP: A Framework for Addressing the Contexts of Poverty* (Shaia, 2019) and explore Socially Engineered Trauma (SET) as detailed in *Socially-Engineered Trauma and a New Social Work Pedagogy: Socioeducation as a Critical Foundation of Social Work Practice* (Shaia et al., 2019). This is an anti-racist, anti-oppressive approach that can be utilized to improve service delivery on the individual, professional, and political levels. Presenters will apply the SHARP framework as a tool to enhance MI practice through the exploration of the Transtheoretical model and use of Core MI Skills.
