2016: Wording of some questions revised from 2015-2016 exam.

2016: Revisions to all Assessment Measurements complying with the new 2015 CSWE (Council on Social Work Education) EPAS Guidelines began in the summer of 2016.

- > The new EPAS Guidelines contain some wording revisions and reduced the number of Core Competencies from **10** to **9**.
- In all of our Assessment Measurements, Core Competency 10A-10D has consistently produced lower scores in relation to every other Core Competency.
- Starting in the spring of 2017, all of our Assessment Measurements will be revised to comply with the 2015 EPAS Core Competency Guidelines
