Downloading SMART and Getting Started

SMART: Two Components

SMART includes two components:

- SMART Notebook: A desktop application for making lessons from scratch that has the most robust creation tools
- <u>Lumio (previously SMART Learning Suite Online)</u>: A web-based version for those who want simple lesson creation starting with something you already have, such as a PDF or PPT.
- You are NOT required to use both components. You can use both or you can use one or the other.

If you choose to use SMART NOTEBOOK

- Download the desktop application at <u>SMART Downloads</u>. Follow prompts.
- After downloading and installing Notebook, open the desktop application and login using your WCU issued Microsoft credentials (email and password).
- All faculty and students in the CESW or in a teacher preparation program are eligible for a SMART subscription. Your subscription includes both the desktop application (SMART Notebook) and the online tool (Lumio). You should automatically have access to the full subscription. *Note: you must continue to login with your WCU credentials.
- <u>SMART Notebook Teacher Guide</u>: Step-by-step guide on how to use Notebook to engage students, enhance lessons and extend learning. Requires download of Notebook.

If you choose to use Lumio (previously SMART LEARNING SUITE ONLINE)

- Go to https://www.smarttech.com/lumio/.
- Tap Teacher login.
- Choose Sign In and then choose Microsoft.
- Sign in using your WCU-issued Microsoft credentials (email and password).
- All faculty and students in the CESW or in a teacher preparation program are eligible for a SMART subscription. Your subscription includes both the desktop application (SMART Notebook) and the online tool (Lumio). You should automatically have access to the full subscription. *Note: you must continue to login with your WCU credentials.
- <u>Lumio Teacher Guide</u>: Step-by-step guide on how to use Lumio to make lessons using existing content like PDFs or PPTs to engage students, enhance lessons, and extend learning. No download of Notebook is required.
