

# SMART Board MX Interactive Touch Panel: Initial Setup

## WHAT IS SMART BOARD MX?

SMART Board Interactive Display Panels are installed in Recitation Hall 204 & 205. The interactive display panel enables you to do everything that you can do at your computer – open and close applications, scroll through files, create new documents or edit existing ones, visit websites, and more – by touching the interactive screen with your finger or SMART pens.

## DOWNLOAD SMART DRIVERS

For PC and Mac users, download the SMART Product Drivers and Ink Downloads [support.smarttech.com/en/downloads/product-drivers](http://support.smarttech.com/en/downloads/product-drivers)

Additional steps for Macs: Check for interactivity and pen functionality. If there is none, follow steps below:

### Connection Wizard:

1. Open Applications > SMART Technologies > SMART Settings. If there is a red X next to The SMART Board service is not running, Tap Connection Wizard. A Connection Wizard Window will pop up. Choose the panel series: SMART Board MX series interactive display. Check mark should now be green.

### Security and Privacy Settings:

2. Go to **Apple** menu > **System Preferences** > **Security & Privacy**
3. Select the **Privacy** tab (If settings are locked, click the lock icon and enter password.)
  - Choose **Accessibility** in the side panel and verify *SMARTBoardService* and *SMART Ink* have a blue checkmark. If they don't appear in the accessibility list on the right see How to add applications to the list below.
  - Choose **Input Monitoring** and complete the same steps as above.
  - Choose **Full Disk Access** and complete the same steps as above.
4. Restart your computer. Upon reboot, you should see the SMART Ink pen icon and SMART Touch tool displayed on the SMART board panel.

## HOW TO ADD APPLICATIONS TO THE ACCESSIBILITY LIST

For Macs:

- Go to **Finder** > **Applications** > **SMART Technologies** > **Drag** the Notebook application from the Finder window to the accessibility list on the right (Select the check box next to the Notebook application).
- In the Finder window, right-click **SMART Settings** > **Show Package Contents** > **Contents** > **MacOS** > **Drag SMARTBoardService** application from the Finder window to the accessibility list on the right (Select the check box next to *SMARTBoardService*, and then restart the computer).
