## 2019-2020 Professional Judgement Hardship Appeal of Parent PLUS Approval

- 5. [] The parent is incarcerated.
- 6. [] The school has examined the family financial information and **documented** the parent's likely inability to repay the PLUS Loan due to an existing debt burden or the parent's expected income-to-debt ratio.
- 7. [] The Parent has, since being approved for the PLUS loan, been turned down for adverse credit in regard to other applications for credit such as for an auto loan, mortgage, major credit card, etc.
