## Grade and General Education Requirement Information

### BS in Nutrition: Sustainable Food Systems Management

#### **NTD GRADE REQUIREMENTS**

- A “C” or better grade is required in all NTD courses and MAT121, ECO111, ACC201, and MKT250.
- If any core or cognate courses have prerequisites, the minimum grade requirements for those prerequisites must be met before the core or cognate course can be taken.
- Transfer courses need to meet these grade requirements to transfer to WCU.

#### **GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS**

##### Covered by our major (NTD) requirements

- 2 Science courses (these are met by BIO100 and CHE107))
- 2 Behavioral and Social Science courses (satisfied by SOC200 or ANT102 & PSY100 in program)
- 1 Mathematics course (satisfied by program requirement of Statistics MAT121)
- 1 “J” course = Diverse Communities (NTD200 is a “J” course)
- 1 “W” course (Writing Emphasis) (NTD450 is a “W” course)
- 1 “I” course (Interdisciplinary) (NTD/ANT277 is a “I” course)

##### Not covered by our major (NTD) requirements

- TWO ENGLISH COMPOSITION courses: WRT120 plus one of the following: 200, 204, 205, 206, 208, or 220.
- TWO HUMANITIES courses (Literature/Comparative Lit., History or Philosophy or other that meets requirements) – these two must be from 2 different categories. Must be an approved Gen Ed course – see link for approved Gen Ed courses: <http://catalog.wcupa.edu/undergraduate/general-education-requirements/approved-gen-ed-course-list/>
- 1 ART course (Art, film/cinema, dance, music, photography, or theater). Must be approved Gen Ed course – see link.
- ONE COMMUNICATIONS course - either SPK208 or SPK230 [or transferred credit “SPK199”]
- Electives (18 credits) – 18 credits of ‘free’ electives. These courses CAN be transferred from another institution.
- 3 “S” Speaking Emphasis courses, 2 will be within the SFSM track (NTD 425, 450)
- 1 “E” Ethics Emphasis course.
- 2 more “W” Writing Emphasis courses (Note: These are courses which place an extra emphasis on writing assignments, they are not English composition [WRT] courses.) A total of 3 writing emphasis courses are required in all, but NTD444 counts as one of them, so you would only need 2 additional courses.

*If you have transferred to WCU with 40-70 credits, you would only need 2 “W” courses in all (one of which is covered by NTD409). If you transferred in with >70 credits, you would only need 1 “W” course, which is covered by NTD450 (so you would not need to take any additional “W” courses). Courses designated “W” in the course schedule booklets may be taken at any time during your program. They may be any subject, and you can take a “W” course that is also an Art, or Humanities, or “I” course, to combine these requirements. It can also be one of your electives.*

#### **NOTES:**

- You can combine an “I” with a “W” course.
- J & W courses cannot be transferred from another institution: “I” courses can transfer from another institution.
- BIO 110 can substitute for BIO 100.
- Apply online for graduation no later than the end of the junior year or when 90 credits have been earned.
- We recommend students work 400-800 hours in food management and/or sustainability before graduating. This allows students to gain broad experience in the field and find out what interests them most. It will also provide them with a potential reference and their experience will allow them to enter the field beyond an entry-level position.
