1. **North Campus Outdoor Classroom and Organic Gardens Internship Opportunity:** *Spring, Summer, and Fall 2022* The WCU Sustainability Council (SC) is seeking to fill two *Outdoor Classroom and Organic Gardens (OCDG) and Pigment and Dye Garden Internship* positions for the 2022 spring, summer, and fall semesters to work in our north campus native plant outdoor classroom and organic garden by the Planetarium, the Tanglewood organic garden, and the Pigment and Dye Garden at the E.O.
