### Accessibility Access in myWCU:

West Chester University is committed to providing access to electronic information and services to people with disabilities. There is now a way for any PeopleSoft (myWCU) user to change the accessibility features. If you change the accessibility setting the look and feel of PeopleSoft will change. There are 3 accessibility options available:

- 1. *Optimize for Screen Readers* For visually impaired users who use assistive technology, such as screen readers.
- 2. *Optimize for Low Vision* For users who need support for visual impairment, but who do not rely solely on screen readers.
- 3. *Turn-Off Accessibility Features* This option turns off accessibility features if a user no longer wants either Option 1 or 2 above. This is the default for all users.

You must be logged-in to myWCU to make accessibility changes. Click here for an <u>online tutorial</u> on how to turn on / off this feature.

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# Don't Forget to Activate your D2L Courses:

All D2L courses are set as "inactive" upon creation. Students do not have access to "inactive" courses.

The below process MUST be followed for each course section at the start of every semester:

- 1. Click on "Edit Course"
- 2. Click "Course Offering Information"
- 3. Check the "Active" checkbox
- 4. Click Save
