West Chester University's *Center for International Programs (CIP)* is proud to offer students the opportunity to apply for the Study Abroad Travel Awards each year. Awards ranging in the amount of \$300.00-\$2,000.00 will be given to selected students participating in approved study abroad programs. West Chester University's Strategic Plan, *Building on Excellence*, has made the objective to increase the international educational opportunities for students a top priority.

Applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Must be a West Chester University degree-seeking student
- Must be participating in a credit-bearing program (either WCU faculty-led program or pre-approved program provider)
- Preference will be given to students demonstrating high financial need.
- Preference will be given to students who have not previously received the Study Abroad Travel Award.

Important Application Dates

Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis, however review of applications for each term will begin on the dates below. Students are encouraged to submit their applications prior to these dates for the highest consideration. Applications submitted after the dates below for each term will be considered based on the criteria above and the availability of funds.

Application Requirements

- Letter of Application Provide a 1 page letter that describes your interest in applying, presents any background knowledge that you feel is relevant, articulates how the study abroad experience that you selected links to your academic and intellectual development, and discuss why you are a deserving candidate for the award.
- Letter of Recommendation One letter from a faculty member or an organizational advisor that knows you well. This letter should speak to your academic ability, communication skills, and readiness for international program participation. The letter must be submitted directly to you by the recommender to include with your application materials.
- □ Official or Unofficial Copy of your Transcript You can download this directly from your MyWCU portal.
- ☐ This Study Abroad Travel Award application form The form must be signed and dated below.
