Conductors may participate in the symposium in one of two different levels. *Conducting participants* will conduct chamber ensembles during the morning sessions and a full wind ensemble in the afternoon. Participation at this level will be limited to the first sixteen applicants with paid deposits. *Observers* will be engaged in all of the daily activities but will not conduct the ensembles.
