Requirement satisfied by MHL 210-Music History I

Science (6 credits) 2 different disciplines (e.g. BIO & ESS)

Biology-BIO 100, 110

Chemistry-CHE 100, 103, 107, 160

Computer Science-CSC 110, 115, 141

Earth Science-ESS 101, 111, 112, 130, 170

Physics-PHY 100, 105, 123, 130, 140, 170, 180

Behavioral/Social Sciences (6 credits): 2 different disciplines

Anthropology-ANT 102, 103

Psychology-PSY 100

Sociology-SOC 200, 240

Economics-ECO 101, 111, 112, 200

Geography-GEO 101, 103

Government-PSC 100, 101, 213

Humanities (6 credits): 2 different disciplines (e.g. LIT/CLS & PHI)

Literature-LIT 100, LIT 165, LIT 219, LIT 220, CLS 165, CLS 260, CLS 261

(Suggested: LIT 165 or CLS 165 for W.E. Credit)

History-HIS 100, 101, 102, 150, 151, 152, 444

Philosophy-PHI 100, 101, 150, 180, 206, 207, 282

NOTE: WCU will continue to accept transfer credits for courses other than those identified as "approved" general education courses, if the course equivalent has the same prefix as those in the science, behavioral and social sciences, humanities, or arts categories within the distributive requirements, including those assigned the 199 course number.

Free Electives

You must reach 120 credits to complete your degree program regardless of AP Credits, Dual Enrollments, Competency Exams, etc. After all of your major and general education requirements are satisfied you may complete your credits with free electives of your choice.

Attribute Courses

Note: these courses must be taken at WCU; they cannot be transferred in.

Diversity "J" (3 credits)

Music Education Majors: satisfied by MUE 332-Methods & Materials II

Note: This course may satisfy both your Diversity requirement as well as another General Education or Music requirement.

Examples are: CLS 165, CLS 260, PHI 180, PSC 101, MHL 125, MUE 332

Interdisciplinary (3 credits)

Satisfied by MHL 212-Music History

Writing Emphasis "W" (9 credits; 3 credits must be 300-400 level)

Music Education Majors: 6 of your 9 credits are satisfied by MUE 331 Satisfied by MUE 332. You need one additional course at any level.

Note: This course may satisfy both your Writing Emphasis requirement as well as another General Education or Music requirement. Writing Emphasis courses are separate from Writing or English courses.

Examples are: CLS 165, CLS 260, LIT 165, MTC 342, MHL 301, MUE 331/332

Transfer Students with

< 40 credits need 9 cr. of W.E.

40-70 credits need 6 cr. of W.E.

> 70 credits need 3 cr. of W.E.
