

BIOGRAPHIES

Kimberly Dunn Adams is the Director of Choral Activities at Western Michigan University, where she directs the University Chorale, Anima, Collegiate Singers, and Grand Chorus. Adams holds degrees in religion and vocal performance from Oberlin College and Conservatory and graduate degrees in choral conducting from the Yale School of Music and the University of Wisconsin-Madison.

Ellen Breakfield-Glick is the Assistant Professor of Clarinet at Western Michigan University and performs with Western Winds and the Western Wind Quintet. Dr. Glick is a graduate of the Eastman School of Music and the University of Michigan.

Conrad Cornelison joined the Detroit Symphony Orchestra as Principal Bassoon in 2022 at the appointment of Music Director Jader Bignamini.
