

Nursing Students Travel to India

Rachel Joseph and Marcia Welsh, assistant professors in the department of nursing, and 10 undergraduate students from the department of nursing travelled to the southern Indian state of Kerala during Winter Session. This visit marked WCU's first official partnership program with India's Government College of Nursing. The students explored core concepts of global health that affect community health and public health access to care in resource-limited settings. They worked to address health concerns of the people living in this region, including improving infant mortality rates and limiting the spread of infectious diseases.
