

# General Education Requirements

The following course is required for every student:

## WRT 120

The following are required courses with the designated variables:

Pick one: WRT 200, WRT 204, WRT 205, WRT 206, WRT 208, WRT 220

Pick one: SPK 208 or SPK 230

Pick one: MAT above 103

## WRITING EMPHASIS

Students are required to complete one to three Writing Emphasis Courses depending on the number of course credits transferred to WCU. **One must be at the 300-400 level. Writing emphasis courses are designated with a “W”** on the student transcript. These courses may be used to fulfill other requirements simultaneously.

All students are required to take a **Diversity Course and an Interdisciplinary Course**. For descriptions of these, refer to the Undergraduate Catalog. **Diversity Courses may be used** to meet other requirements simultaneously, but students must still complete the required number of total credits to graduate. **Interdisciplinary Courses may NOT fulfill** any of the general education distributive requirements (science, behavioral sciences, humanities or arts requirements **except** Writing Emphasis).
