Take PSY100 plus 15 additional hours of PSY courses (minimum grade of C-) for a total of 6 courses in Psychology. At least 6 credits (2 courses) must be advanced standing courses (i.e., any 300-400 level courses and 200 level courses bolded in list below).

Note: You must take at least 1/2 of your minor credit hours at WCU - you cannot count more than 9 credit hours of transfer credit towards your minor.


