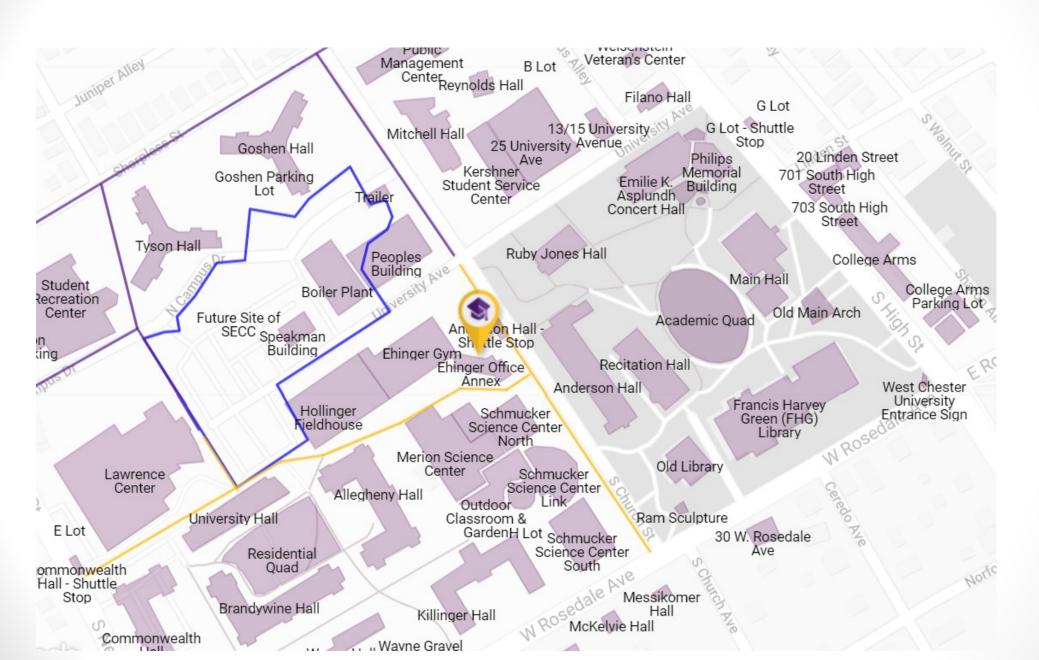

- Supporting the formation of interdisciplinary teams.
- Supporting the development of intellectual property.
- Supporting the integration of research and creative activity into coursework.
- Supporting faculty/student collaboration, especially as it relates to undergraduate research experiences





#### PROPOSAL DEVELOPMENT

All grants or contracts that support your research must be coordinated with ORSP.

**STEP 4: Proofreading and editing** 

STEP 5: Routing the proposal for internal permissions and ensuring research

compliance
