The West Chester University Resource Pantry supports student success by minimizing food and basic need insecurity and preparing students for life after graduation. The pantry offers nonperishable food, fresh produce, personal care items, school supplies, as well as professional and winter attire.

Who Can Shop?



Any student (undergraduate & graduate) is welcome to shop at the pantry. The pantry does **not require** the student to provide documentation or **proof of income**. Students only need to provide their WCU ID number. No student will be turned away from the pantry.

Monday-Friday | 10am-4pm
